An overview of the evaluation results (Flash Call Info) of the call H2020-ICT-2015 is available since 15 August [here](#). 1298 proposals were submitted and 638 out of them received an evaluation score above the applicable threshold. The applicants have been informed about the results, one of them is **PI-SCALE** project focused on flexible organic electronics which was supported during the proposal preparation phase by AMIRES. The number of proposals that can finally be funded depends on the available budget and the completion of the formal procedures needed to conclude grant agreements. It is expected that the first grant agreements will be signed by 13 November 2015.

WHAT'S NEW IN EUROPEAN R&D



European Innovation Council

European Commissioner for Research, Innovation and Science Carlos Moedas announced on 22 June 2015, during the ERA in Innovation conference in Brussels, that he would like to design “a European Innovation Council” (EIC), “**one stop shop for innovators**”. It should be modelled to the successful European Research Council (ERC). Many points are still unclear. The best practices could be targeted at how the EIC could be set up. They could be compiled as input to the mid-term review of Horizon 2020.



Innovation Radar report

The European Commission Joint Research Center has published a report on Innovation Radar (IR), a support initiative that focuses on the identification of high-potential innovations in the **ICT FP7, CIP and Horizon 2020** projects and the key organisation in delivering these innovations to the market. Over 4000 project factsheets from Horizon 2020 were published and can now be browsed and searched on CORDIS through their programme area and topic. Currently the information available covers project acronym, costs, topic, funding scheme, objectives, coordinating and participating organisations and the EC contribution for each beneficiary. Further data is planned to be added, including project websites, contact persons and cross-cutting domains. Swiss participation in H2020

Rudolf Fryček as a coach of [Platin](#), Swiss innovation platform supporting start-ups and SMEs, wrote an article (only in French) about Swiss companies participating in the H2020 Programme (“Les entreprises suisses bénéficiaires du programme Horizon 2020”). Based on the statistics, in the first half of 2014 the success rates of the Swiss participants (19 %) as well as the coordinators (23 %) were the highest in the whole Europe. ULTRAPLACAD (ULTRASensitive PLAsmonic devices for early CAncer Diagnosis) project website www.ultraplacad.eu has been set up in order to increase public awareness of the project, research progress in cancer diagnosis devices and to disseminate project's results. Provisional website with basic information on the project had been operational already from the start of the project, May 2015. The final version of the website was launched this week. It will be actively maintained during the whole course of the project. Some members of AMIRES team have personal experience from Nepal so when the message about the earthquake came we have been really shocked and sad.
