

The COST (European Cooperation in Science and Technology) Committee of Senior Officials (CSO) approved during the November meeting held in November in Sofia, Bulgaria 40 new Actions. They were among the proposals submitted for the March 2014 Collection Date and are the last ones reflecting the domain-oriented structure. The next round of approved Actions is expected in November 2015 and will mirror the new scientific organisation. A complete Action list with their description is available [here](#).

WHAT'S NEW IN EUROPEAN R&D



Agreement between the EU and Switzerland signed

In the last issue of our newsletter you were informed about the agreement Switzerland and the EU found for a so-called **partial association** to Horizon 2020. The comprehensive international agreement was signed on **5th December 2014**, however, it came into effect on **15 September 2014** and will initially run until the end of 2016. It allows researchers in Switzerland to again participate as associated and equally entitled partners in all activities under the **first pillar** of Horizon 2020 (**Excellent Science**). As associated partners, researchers in Switzerland will again receive direct funding from the EU. In addition, Switzerland will also participate as an associated country in the Euratom Programme and the ITER project. In all other parts of the Horizon 2020 programme, Switzerland will remain a **third country participant**. **The first statistics of H2020 show, the Swiss applicants**

and even Swiss coordinators are still very successful, even under these “third country” conditions. The Swiss State Secretariat for Education, Research and Innovation SERI has also released in November a [guideline document](#) for all Swiss partners successful during evaluations. **Beyond 2016**, association to the programmes will depend on Swiss measures to ensure the **non-discrimination of Croatian citizens and researchers**. If Switzerland resolves the issue of the free movement of persons by February 2017, the association will expand to the whole of Horizon 2020 including the parts not yet covered. Otherwise, the whole agreement will be automatically terminated.



EU Industrial R&D Investment Scoreboard 2014

The European Commission published 2014 EU Industrial R&D Investment Scoreboard, which analyses the top 2500 companies worldwide, representing about 90% of the total business R&D expenditure. Investment in R&D by companies based in the EU **grew by 2.6%** in 2013, despite the unfavourable economic environment. However, this growth has slowed in comparison to the previous year's 6.8%. It is also below the 2013 world average (4.9%), and lags behind the companies based in the US (5%) and Japan (5.5%). The EU overall performance is largely **driven by** companies based in three countries: **Germany, France and the UK**. More information is available [here](#).

A brokerage event will encourage delegates to exchange ideas, network and meet potential research partners. A stream will be available. A new call for proposals for Smart Cities and Communities solutions integrating energy, transport and ICT through lighthouse projects under Horizon 2020 (**SCC-01-2015**) will open on **10 December 2014** (deadline date for submitting proposals is **5 May 2015**). OpenAIRE2020

A year after the start of the Horizon 2020, OpenAIRE enters a new phase of funding with a continuation project: OpenAIRE2020, starting in **January 2015**. The initiative will implement the H2020 **Open Access** policies and mandates for publications and will be one of the key European infrastructures supporting the EC's **Research Data Pilot**.
